The shipping versions of both AcqKnowledge and BSL were created prior to the release of Mac Catalina 10.15.XX and Mac added additional security for this OS. There are two concerns with relatively easy workarounds:

 Installation may display a warning: "<application.pkg> can't be opened because Apple cannot check it for malicious software...

Workaround: Right click on the installer and select Open

2. Double clicking will not Launch the application Workaround 1: Right click on the application and choose Open from the contextual menu, which will launch the application.

Workaround 2: In the Finder on your Mac, locate the app you want to open.

Don't use Launchpad to do this. Launchpad doesn't allow you to access the shortcut menu.

- 1. Control-click the app icon, then choose Open from the shortcut menu.
- 2. Click Open.

The app is saved as an exception to your security settings, and you can open it in the future by double-clicking it just as you can any registered app."
